

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Baptist Health Foundation's Community Support Fund

- ***What is the timeline for grants from Baptist Health Foundation?***

We have one grant cycle per year. It normally opens in early April and the deadline to apply is August 15. Applications are reviewed during September and October and Grant recipients are notified during the first week of November.

- ***What is Baptist Health Foundation looking for in grant recipient?***

We are invested in five Baptist Health Hospitals- Brookwood, Princeton, Shelby, Walker, and Citizens. The healthcare needs they have identified in their communities are also important to us. Organizations who partner with them or provide a service they value for their patients are of great interest to us.

- ***What if my organization does not have a connection to those hospitals?***

Not every successful applicant will have a current relationship. Sometimes we seek to forge new partnerships on behalf of the hospitals. Or to support healthcare or healthcare related services for the communities where we provide healthcare.
